This is a database-in-progress of extant local ecclesiastical legislation issued across Latin Christendom from ca. 1215 - ca. 1400. The corpus includes mainly diocesan statutes and provincial canons, but other genres appear on occasion. The database currently includes 1400 texts, accounting for nearly ninety percent of the extant material from the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries. Most of these texts have been taken from modern and early modern editions, but others have been transcribed directly from manuscripts.


Spelling and editorial conventions vary considerably, whether in medieval manuscripts or their modern editions. The main corpus preserves this variety, but an alternate version is available in which the most frequent variants have been normalized (e.g. v→u, j→i, ae→e).
